TWENTY-ONE SUGGESTIONS TO LIVE BY

1. Give people more than they expect and do it cheerfully.
2. Marry the right person; someone you love to talk to. As you get older, their conversational skills will be as important as any other.
3. Don't believe all you hear, spend all you have or sleep all you want.
4. When you say, "I love you," mean it.
